ANNOUNCEMENTS:**Trivia Night: An Explanation**

Msgr. Fritz has been so kind as to let me take a little time to explain what the "Trivia Night" Fundraiser is about. Therefore, here is a little break down:

Trivia Night is a group of family, friends, co-workers etc. who have gotten together to compete against others in trying to answer fun questions in different categories. Cost is \$10 per person (\$100 per table of 10). The hosts (St. Stanislaus Parish in this case) pick a theme of the night, we chose "Cubs Win" because we hope it would draw a larger group of people (the idea is to raise money *for* the parish not necessarily *from* the parish). The hall will be decorated with the Cubbies colors of Red/Blue with balloons, banners, etc.

Everyone is asked to bring food for his/her table to share (however, this is *not* a requirement to play). Drinks, (beer, pop, water, etc.) will be available for purchase of which St. Stan will get a percentage of those sales.

The trivia categories range from movies, history, local news, presidents, geography, sports, religion, quotes, etc. Each category has 10 questions and your team must come up with the best answer. The whole objective is to be the "smartest table in the bunch". As each round is completed, the score sheets are brought up to the judges & graded. At that time, the score for your table will be posted on a spreadsheet. There is a lot of good nature kidding about who ranks where & usually the last place team will end up with a round of drinks on the house! The winning team after 10 rounds will receive \$200 in prize money.

After three rounds, there is a short break in which either a 50/50 raffle is held, another type of game is played just to give everyone time to stretch their legs, refill their drinks or take a quick break. Don't be afraid that you won't know the answers, it's okay, there is always a good chance someone on your team will, and if they don't, who cares? We are there for fun and fellowship. There is a lot of laughter at Trivia Nights!

So please, ask your friends, family, co-workers & reserve that table. You will have a wonderful time!

Evening for Men:


There will be *no* Evening for Men in January. The mens' group will meet again on Monday, February 20.
