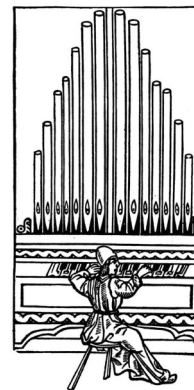
**First Communion / Confirmation :**
