### ANNOUNCEMENTS:

#### Organ Update:

Due to illness, the owner of Triune Music was not able to voice the organ last week; he is better and the organ will be operational beginning this Tuesday. The organ will be blessed prior to the 7pm Mass this Thursday (see below). A showcase of the organ is still planned to occur after Easter.

#### Candlemas:

This Thursday, **Feb. 2**, is the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary. There will be no morning Mass; there will be at **7:00pm** the Blessing and Distribution of Candles and Procession, followed immediate by sung Mass. If you would like blessed candles for your personal use, please provide them yourself, and bring them to church before Mass. Please note that these candles must have *some* beeswax in them. If you have other candles not made of beeswax, they require a different blessing, so please contact Msgr. Fritz to arrange a convenient time to have them blessed.

#### THE FEAST OF ST. BLAISE:

##### Blessing of Bread, Wine, Water, and Fruit:

In honor of St. Blaise, these items will be blessed to empower them to heal ailments of the throat to those who devoutly make pious use of them. It is a laudable practice to take these blessed items to those who are not able to come to church and have their throats blessed by a priest with candles.

##### Blessing of Throats:

In honor of St. Blaise, throats (and the items listed above) will be blessed following the 6:30pm Mass on Friday, **Feb. 3**.

##### First Friday - Devotion to the Sacred Heart:

Remember that there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on Friday at 5:30pm. The Litany of the Sacred Heart will be recited at 6:10pm with Benediction to follow. Mass will begin at 6:30pm. Following Mass, the Blessings in honor of St. Blaise will take place.

### First Communion / Confirmation :

Please contact Msgr. Fritz by this Wednesday, **Feb. 1** if you have a child who has reached the age of reason and would like to receive First Holy Communion. Once the number of children is known, preparation classes will be scheduled.

If you are aged 13 or older, have not received the Sacrament of Confirmation and would like to do so, by Feb. 1, please contact Msgr. Fritz.

### Blessing of Bread and Water in Honor of St. Adelheid:

St. Adelheid (†1015) was abbess of Villich near Bonn (Germany). The saint caused a fountain to spring up in an arid region; the water from which was credited with the curing of fevers. Bread and Water are blessed in her honor and given the power to heal, particularly from fevers, those who devoutly eat and drink these sacramentals. This blessing will be bestowed *next* Sunday, **Feb. 5** (the date of her feast), following each of the Masses.
