#### Blessing of Bread and Water in Honor of St. Adelheid:

St. Adelheid (†1015) was abbess of Villich near Bonn (Germany). The saint caused a fountain to spring up in an arid region; the water from which was credited with the curing of fevers. Bread and Water are blessed in her honor and given the power to heal, particularly from fevers, those who devoutly eat and drink these sacramentals. This blessing will be bestowed today, Sunday, **Feb. 5** (the date of her feast), following each of the Masses.
