#### February 10 - Ash Wednesday:

Ash Wednesday it is a day of obligatory **fast** and **abstinence**.

Distribution of Ashes will take place at the following times:

7:30am and 12:15pm—Distribution of Ashes *only*

7:00pm—Distribution of Ashes *and* sung Mass

#### Current Law for Fasting and Abstinence:

Fasting is required of all from the age of 18 until 59; one full meal is permitted per day, two smaller meals may be taken which together would not equal a full meal. No other food may be taken. Abstinence from meat is binding on those aged 14 and above.

#### Friday Lenten Devotions:

Every Friday in Lent, there will be Stations of the Cross at 6pm and following Mass, there will be a potluck soup supper.

#### Children's Choir:
