His Excellency, Bishop Rhoades, will be coming to consecrate the parish to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. It is Msgr. Fritz's desire that each parishioner will make *personal* preparation for this consecration by following the method of St. Louis de Montfort. The 33 days of preparation should begin on Thurs., April 3.

They serve lunch each Mon., Wed., Fri. and, on any given day, serve about 300 meals. This is way to have a direct impact on those less fortunate in our neighborhood. A bin will be placed in the back of church for this drive – thank you and may God reward your generosity.

Current Law for Fasting and Abstinence:

Fasting is required of those from the age of 18 until 59; one full meal is permitted per day, two smaller meals may be taken which together would not equal a full meal. No other food may be taken. Abstinence from meat is binding on those aged 14 and above.

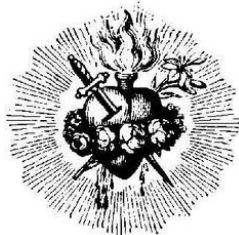
