THE BISHOP IS COMING!

Mark your calendars – **April 4, 2016**

His Excellency, Bishop Rhoades, will be coming to consecrate the parish to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. It is Msgr. Fritz's desire that each parishioner will make *personal* preparation for this consecration by following the method of St. Louis de Montfort. The 33 days of preparation should begin on Thurs., Mar. 3.

Friday Lenten Devotions:

Every Friday in Lent, there will be Stations of the Cross at 6pm, low Mass at 6:30pm, the recitation of the Litany of the Sacred Heart, and then there will be a potluck soup supper.

Lenten Corporal Work of Mercy:

The parish is collecting canned goods, rice, dry pasta, and other non-perishable food for the *St. Augustine Soup Kitchen* which is located a half-mile from St. Stanislaus and serves our neighborhood poor and the homeless. They serve lunch each Mon., Wed., Fri. and, on any given day, serve about 300 meals. This is way to have a direct impact on those less fortunate in our neighborhood. A bin will be placed in the back of church for this drive – thank you and may God reward your generosity.

Children's Choir:

The St. Stanislaus Children's Choir has begun! Practice is every Tues. from 7:30pm until 8:30pm. Msgr. Fritz strongly encourages *every* child from the age of 5 to 15 to join this choir. The primary purpose of the choir is musical education and formation; the children will learn the Solfege method and will be singing sacred music, *ie*, plainchant. This is an important part of the formation of young Catholics, please take advantage of this.

Current Law for Fasting and Abstinence:

Fasting is required of those from the age of 18 until 59; one full meal is permitted per day, two smaller meals may be taken which together would not equal a full meal. No other food may be taken. Abstinence from meat is binding on those aged 14 and above.

CLARIFICATION:

Msgr Fritz **erred** in his inclusion of meat *broth* in the things forbidden by prescribed abstinence. Soup and gravy made from meat is forbidden, but it meat broth is not.

Church cleaning:

A very sincere *thank you* to all those who came and gave the church a "deep cleaning" on Saturday; we appreciate the time and energy it takes to care for our parish church. There will be another thorough cleaning of the church on **Sat., March 19** to get the church ready for Holy Week. We need more volunteers! Please come! St. Stanislaus is a *personal* parish, so each of needs to take *personal* responsibility for the parish. It is an appropriate sign of gratitude to God, who has allowed this parish to continue, by taking loving care of His house.
