Directions to the Parish Hall/“Cry Room” and Bathrooms:

The parish hall is located in the basement of the church; this also functions as a “Cry Room” during Mass (there is a live feed of the Mass on a tv monitor so that you can still follow along). It is accessed by either the staircase near the bathroom at the rear of church (by the statue of St. Anne), or by the elevator (by the statue of St. Thérèse) – please do not use the elevator *unless* there is need.

Also, there are two bathrooms in the church hall near the kitchen.

Conferral of the Sacrament of Confirmation:

The Most Rev. Kevin Rhoades, Bishop of Ft. Wayne-South Bend, will confer the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Traditional Rite at St. Stanislaus, Bishop and Martyr parish on Sunday, **December 17, 2017**. Details will be provided as the date becomes proximate.

Appropriate Attire:
