#### From the Diocese: Safe Environment

It remains important for our Church to protect children and young persons from the evils of abuse. To abuse a child is a grave sin. The Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend remains committed to upholding and following its guidelines, policies and procedures that were implemented for the Protection of Children and Young People. These can be reviewed on the Diocesan website, [www.diocesefwsb.org](http://www.diocesefwsb.org) under "Youth Protection."

If you have reason to believe that a child may be a victim of child abuse or neglect, Indiana law requires that you report this to civil authorities. If you or someone you know was abused as a child or young person by an adult, you are encouraged to notify appropriate civil authorities of that abuse.

The diocese is committed to helping prevent the abuse or neglect of children and young people, and to assist those who claim to have suffered harm as a result of such abuse.

## Directions to the Parish Hall/"Cry Room" and Bathrooms:

*Did you know?* Safe Environment training is taking place in all dioceses of the United States. Over two million clergy, employees, and volunteers have been trained to prevent and respond to the abuse of children.
