May Crowning:

The Crowning of the Blessed Virgin Mary will take place on *today*, Sunday, **May 14** at the end of the 10am Mass. Please participate in the devotions and procession honoring our Blessed Mother.

The Marian procession this year is led by the girls of the Little Flowers group; you may notice that they are decked out in attire that features floral crowns – today they dress in imitation of Our Lady to express their desire and attempt to imitate the Blessed Virgin interiorly through virtue and grace.

Each flower in the crown that our Little Flowers wear represents a virtue about which they learned this past year. The virtues form a wreath of flowers that they offer to Our Lady as they learn to become true children of Mary. Here are the flowers and corresponding virtue: Sunflower: Faith; Ivy: Hope; Peony: Love of God; Rose: Love of Neighbor; Carnation: Obedience; Forget-me-not: Piety; Violet: Humility; Daffodil: Industry; Narcissus: Truthfulness.

Early next week, we expect to know a start date for construction, and also a timeline of the work to be done in the sanctuary. Here are some of the financial details of the project:
