Dear Friends in Christ,

The Lord continues to bless our diocese with the gift of priestly vocations. This year I will ordain two men to the priesthood and five men to the diaconate who, please God, will be ordained priests next year. We give thanks to God for these young men who are committing their lives to the service of the Church.

Next Sunday is the Solemnity of Pentecost, the feast in which we celebrate the great event when the apostles received the Holy Spirit, together with Mary and the first community of Christ's disciples. Every year on Pentecost Sunday, we take up a very important special collection to provide the financial means for the education of our seminarians. It is an appropriate feast for this collection since the Holy Spirit is the source of all ministry in the Church. Our seminarians are discerning, with the light and guidance of the Holy Spirit, their vocation to the priesthood.

Every time I celebrate an ordination, I am struck by the remarkable mystery of this sacrament in which the men being ordained receive a special outpouring of the Holy Spirit, empowering them to fulfill the ministry entrusted to them. By the power of the Holy Spirit, they are able to act in Christ's name and to be instruments of His grace.

I humbly ask for your generosity in the Pentecost Collection. Your sacrifice is a sign of your appreciation for the gift of the priesthood and of your support for our young men studying for the priesthood. We need your support since the monies raised in the Annual Bishop's Appeal are not enough to fund the education of our seminarians. I am very grateful for whatever donation you can make. I also ask for your prayers for our seminarians and also for more priestly vocations in our diocese.

May the Lord bless you! May the Holy Spirit fill your hearts with the joy and peace of following Christ as His faithful disciples!

**Sanctuary Renovation: Update**

A line rendition has been submitted, and we've made suggested alterations to it; the artist is now preparing the color rendition of the altar.

Work will begin in the sanctuary on Monday, **June 5**. The first week will see the removal of the altar pieces and demolition of the floor. The construction of the new sanctuary floor perimeter will hopefully be accomplished before Sunday. The containers bearing the altar pieces from Toledo are due to arrive on site on June 12 and installation will begin at that time.

The work will be done Monday through Thursday from 6am until 4pm. **Therefore, beginning June 5, Mass on weekdays will be moved to the evening.**

We still need to raise money for Phase 3, and we are still working on the details to establish the amount needed. It is a tremendous legacy to have a stake in the construction of a place where the Sacrifice of the Mass will be offered for generations to come!
