Once again we will be keeping vigil for the Feast of St. John the Baptist. Traditionally, on the Vigil (Friday, **June 23**), there is a blessing of a bonfire to prepare for this great saint's feast.

David and Jacqué Sheedy [5429 N. 800 E. New Carlisle] will be hosting this year's bonfire. Mass will be at 5:00pm, and the bonfire will begin at 6:00pm and run until 8:00pm.

This bonfire is also used to dispose of blessed objects that are worn out or no longer used (eg, scapulars); so feel free to bring these types of things and Msgr. Fritz will dispose of them for you.
