<u>Vigil of St. John the Baptist Bonfire</u>:

Once again we will have a bonfire on the Vigil of the Feast of St. John the Baptist (Friday, **June 23**).

This year's bonfire will be hosted by David and Jacqué Sheedy [5429 N. 800 E. New Carlisle]. It will begin at 6:00pm with the blessing of the bonfire, and festivities will run until 8:00pm. [Mass will be at 5:00pm at church that day.]

This bonfire is also used to dispose of blessed objects that are worn out or no longer used (eg, scapulars); so feel free to bring these types of things and Msgr. Fritz will dispose of them for you.

As it is Friday, and vigils are traditionally a day of abstinence, we will be having a fish fry; please bring a (meatless) dish to share, and your own beverage. *Please* use the sign-up sheets in the back of church to help us organize the event.

Coffee and Doughnuts:

Volunteers are needed to distribute doughnuts after the 10am Mass. Doughnuts and beverages will be delivered to the basement each week prior to Mass and volunteers need only to be at the doughnut table and ready to hand out doughnuts before the onslaught of eager and hungry children (and adults).
