Clothes are to conceal rather than reveal the body; it is considered immodest to wear garments that unduly draw attention to certain parts of the body, regardless of whether this is by the cut (too revealing), the fit (too snug), or the fabric (too clingy, flesh-tones, et al.) of the item.
