St. Anne Novena:

The Novena to St. Anne begins this **Monday, July 17**; there will be *two* Masses: the regularly scheduled 7:00am, and an additional Mass to "kick off" the novena at 6:30pm.

The normally scheduled Evening for Men / Holy League of Prayers will be adapted so as to incorporate the start of the novena. The schedule for *Monday* is as follows:

7:00am:	Mass / Novena Prayer
5:15pm - 6:15pm:	Confessions
6:30pm:	Votive Mass of St. Anne <i>[in thanksgiving - espec. the organ]</i>
7:00pm - 8:00pm:	Exposition of the Bl. Sacrament Holy League Prayers Rosary (Joyful Mysteries) Novena Prayer
8:00pm:	Benediction

Public recitation of the novena prayer will occur following each Mass from July 17 through July 25.

If you are unable to attend the public recitation, please say this prayer devoutly each day.

For your convenience, the prayer for the Novena to St. Anne is on the other side of this bulletin.

The novena will conclude on July 26, the Feast of St. Anne. On that day Mass will be at 6:30pm. As this is the patronal feast of the Ladies' Sodality of the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Anne, following Mass, there will be an *ice cream social* - you should have received an invitation to this event already; if you have not, please contact Msgr. Fritz.

Furthermore, Msgr. Fritz asks that during this novena, we all make some special sacrifice (eg, abstaining from meat or fasting on one of the days).
