Here are some directions to guide you:

Directions to the Parish Hall/"Cry Room" and Bathrooms:

The parish hall is located in the basement of the church; this also functions as a "Cry Room" during Mass (there is a live feed of the Mass on a tv monitor so that you can still follow along). It is accessed by either the staircase near the bathroom at the rear of church (by the statue of St. Anne), or by the elevator (by the statue of St. Thérèse) – please do *not* use the elevator unless there is need. Also, there are two bathrooms in the church hall near the kitchen.

The Church Roof:

The church has its new roof! The work has been completed, and Msgr. Fritz would like to send Bishop Rhoades a token of our gratitude for the new church roof; but before doing so, would like suggestions as to the most appropriate way of expressing our appreciation. We need to show our gratitude to him for giving us, not only this great gift, but this sign of his support and encouragement of the parish.

Parish Social: Coffee-Doughnuts / Potluck:

Following the 10am Mass on Sunday, there are available for a free-will donation coffee and doughnuts. Also, there will be a potluck brunch. This event is located in the basement of the church; please join us at this social event. Thank you!

Votive Candles:

If you would like to light votive candles out of devotion, please ask an usher, an altar server, or the priest to provide you with a candle. The cost of the candles are \$3 each.

St. Anne Novena:

The Novena to St. Anne will begin Sunday, **July 17**. Public recitation of the prayer given below will occur following each Mass; if you are unable to attend the public recitation, please devoutly say this prayer each day. The novena will conclude on **July 26**, the Feast of St. Anne. On that day at 6:00pm, devotions will commence with the Angelus and recitation of the Rosary, followed by Mass at 6:30pm. Following Mass, there will be Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Msgr. Fritz asks that during this novena, you make some special sacrifice (eg, abstaining from meat or fasting on one of the days – see the quote from St. Francis below). The special intention of this novena is the good of our parish.



Prayer to St. Anne:
