#### Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary:

This Tuesday, **August 15** is a holy day of obligation. For your convenience, there will be Mass at 7:00am and 7:00pm.

His Excellency, Kevin Rhoades, Bishop of Ft. Wayne-South Bend will be present at the 7:00pm Mass and give the sermon.



#### Evening for Men:

#### St. Augustine of Hippo:

On Monday, **Aug. 28**, a first class relic of St. Augustine will be exposed for veneration during 7:00am Mass; opportunity for individual veneration will be provided immediately following Mass. If you would like to venerate the relic at another time that day, please contact Msgr. Fritz.

#### Blessing of Water for the Sick & Candles:

Following 7:00am Mass on Thursday, **August 31** and *again at 7:00pm*, there will be a blessing of water and candles in honor of St. Raymond Nonnatus. This water differs from "normal" Holy Water in that it is specifically blessed to help the sick. One who suffers from fever may be bathed in this water, sprinkled with it, or may drink it; indeed, it is the prayer of the Church that anyone who reverently and devoutly drinks or touches this water may regain health in body and spirit, and may persevere in the service of God. The candles are blessed with the explicit purpose to drive away and set to flight spirits of darkness.

**Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary:**

On Sept. 8, we will not only celebrate Our Lady’s birthday, but also the second anniversary of St. Stanislaus parish being under the care of the FSSP. To join in the festivities, we will be hosting Fr. John Berg, the Superior General of the FSSP, and Fr. Gerard Saguto, the District Superior. Thus, we will have a Solemn Mass at 7:00pm on Friday, **Sept. 8.**

**St. Stanislaus Parish Picnic:**

**Sanctuary Renovation: Update**

The statues have arrived and been placed in the altar. These statues of St. Stanislaus, our patron, and St. Hedwig occupied the pedestals in the main entrance of the church. They have been repaired, painted and moved to a place of greater honor. The paint scheme reflects a more historically accurate coloration the previously. The sky blue dalmatic was common in the 11th Century; and that was a time when the vestments were not of the same color. St. Hedwig features a gray habit because when she entered the Carthusians, she did not take the vow of poverty so as to personally distribute her wealth to the poor. Notice, too, that the church she holds is painted to resemble our church.

We are still working to be able to afford these remaining items: a new sanctuary floor surface, the refinishing of the pulpit and a new altar rail. We hope to do so with the amount we have currently raised for this project. Currently, we are in the bidding stage for these projects. So do please continue to be generous to this important project.
