ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Evening for Men:

The next Evening for Men will be tomorrow, Monday, **August 21**. Confessions will be heard from 5:15pm to 6pm; following the Angelus, Msgr. Fritz will give a talk. At approximately 6:30pm, there will be Exposition and Holy Hour with refreshments and social to follow.

During Exposition, the prayers of the Holy League will be said, along with the Rosary. The Holy League, in a Spirit of Marian Chivalry, under the patronage of Our Lady of Guadalupe and Saint Joseph, seeks to provide opportunities for men to forge bonds of fraternity, and to unite in prayer, especially monthly Eucharistic Holy Hours, for purification from sin and predisposition to Grace.

St. Augustine of Hippo:

On Monday, **Aug. 28**, a first class relic of St. Augustine will be exposed for veneration during 7:00am Mass; opportunity for individual veneration will be provided immediately following Mass. If you would like to venerate the relic at another time that day, please contact Msgr. Fritz.

Blessing of Water for the Sick & Candles:

Following 7:00am Mass on Thursday, **August 31** and *again at 7:00pm*, there will be a blessing of water and candles in honor of St. Raymond Nonnatus. This water differs from "normal" Holy Water in that it is specifically blessed to help the sick. One who suffers from fever may be bathed in this water, sprinkled with it, or may drink it; indeed, it is the prayer of the Church that anyone who reverently and devoutly drinks or touches this water may regain health in body and spirit, and may persevere in the service of God. The candles are blessed with the explicit purpose to drive away and set to flight spirits of darkness.

First Friday Devotions:

On **September 1**, there will be Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament at 5:30pm with the recitation of the Litanies of the Sacred Heart at 6:10pm and Benediction just before the 6:30pm Mass.

Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary:

On Sept. 8, we will not only celebrate Our Lady’s birthday, but also the second anniversary of St. Stanislaus parish being under the care of the FSSP. To join in the festivities, we will be hosting Fr. John Berg, the Superior General of the FSSP, and Fr. Gerard Saguto, the District Superior. Thus, we will have a Solemn Mass at 7:00pm on Friday, **Sept. 8**.

St. Stanislaus Parish Picnic:
