In Honor of St. Elizabeth of Hungary:

In order to honor St. Elizabeth of Hungary on her feast day, Thursday, Nov. 19, and to recall the Miracle of the Roses in which the bread she was carrying turned miraculously to roses as divine approbation of her charitable work, there will be the Blessing of Bread and Cakes. At 6:30pm, there will be Solemn Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament with devotions. Following Benediction, the blessing of breads and cakes will take place. Also, please bring non-perishable food items for the poor. Imitation of the saints is the best way to honor them!
