#### Installation of Msgr. John Fritz, FSSP as Pastor of St. Stanislaus:

The installation will begin at 7:00pm; the simple ceremony takes about 30 minutes. Following the installation, there will be Solemn Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament and Benediction. ### **Appropriate Attire:**

To dress becomingly for God and neighbor, and in keeping with the reverence due to the Blessed Sacrament, kindly refrain from wearing shorts, tee-shirts, tank-tops, revealing blouses, sleeveless or backless dresses, form-fitting clothing of any sort, or any other raffish clothing.

Do let your dresses and skirts fall below your knees. Ladies are highly encouraged to cover their heads whilst in church according to Apostolic Tradition and Sacred Scripture (see 1 Cor. 11:2-16); men are highly encouraged to wear suits and ties, or at least dress slacks and collared shirts. With due regard to time and circumstance, we encourage all to wear decorous attire befitting the sacred place and divine worship.

### **Special Message from the Pastor:**

Two thefts have occurred at St. Stanislaus in the last four weeks; one on Oct. 27 and the second last Sunday. Money from the votive candles was stolen. Each time, the perpetrator entered the church through an open / unlocked door. Please be aware of your surroundings: be sure all doors close securely behind you when you leave, never leave the church unattended if the doors are unlocked, etc. Thank you.
