Blessing of Bread and Water in Honor of St. Adelheid:

St. Adelheid (†1015) was abbess of Villich near Bonn (Germany). The saint caused a fountain to spring up in an arid region; the water from which was credited with the curing of fevers. Bread and Water are blessed in her honor and given the power to heal, *particularly from fevers*, those who devoutly eat and drink these sacramentals. This blessing will be bestowed *tomorrow* Monday, **Feb. 5** (the date of her feast), following the 7:00am Mass, and at the conclusion of Confessions at 6:00pm.

February 14 - Ash Wednesday:

Ash Wednesday is a day of obligatory **fast** and **abstinence**. Distribution of Ashes will take place at the following times:

7:30am and 12:15pm—Distribution of Ashes *only*

7:00pm—Distribution of Ashes *and* Mass

The *Confraternity of St. Peter* is a society which gathers those who feel close to the Priestly Fraternity of Saint Peter (FSSP), and who wish to support its charism through prayers and sacrifices. Thus the Confraternity contributes to the service of the Church, through supporting numerous vocations, the sanctification of priests and their pastoral endeavors.

By decree of the Sacred Apostolic Penitentiary, dated June 7, 2008, a *plenary* indulgence is granted, under the usual conditions, to the members of the *Confraternity of St. Peter*

- b) the day of the feast of the Chair of St. Peter (**Feb. 22**);
- c) the day of the feast of Sts. Peter and Paul (June 29).
