February 14 - Ash Wednesday:

Ash Wednesday is a day of obligatory **fast** and **abstinence**. Distribution of Ashes will take place at the following times (*note:* there will be *no* Mass in the morning):

7:30am and 12:15pm—Distribution of Ashes *only*

7:00pm—Distribution of Ashes *and* Mass

*** If you have old, blessed Palms, you may give them to Msgr. Fritz by Feb. 11 for disposal.*

Evening for Men:

Due to the occurrence of Ash Wednesday, the schedule for the Evening for Men will be modified. This Wed., **Feb. 14**, Confessions will be heard from 5:15pm until 5:45pm followed by Exposition of the Bl. Sacrament with the usual prayers of the Holy League and Rosary. Blessing of Ashes and Mass will begin at 7pm. There will be no talk or social time this month.

The Holy League, in a Spirit of Marian Chivalry, under the patronage of Our Lady of Guadalupe and Saint Joseph, seeks to provide opportunities for men to forge bonds of fraternity, and to unite in prayer, especially monthly Eucharistic Holy Hours, for purification from sin and predisposition to Grace.

Lenten Devotions:

This Friday (**Feb. 16**) is the first Friday of Lent. The *Stations of the Cross* will be at 6:00pm, followed by low Mass at 6:30pm. Immediately following Mass, there will be Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament with Benediction at 7:30pm.



Feast of the Chair of St. Peter:

On the evening of Thursday, **Feb. 22**, there will be a sung Mass for this feast of St. Peter as it is allowed to be celebrated in apostolates of the FSSP as a feast of the *first class*. Mass will begin at **7:00pm** – please note: there will be no morning Mass that day.



Confraternity of St. Peter:

Plenary Indulgence

The *Confraternity of St. Peter* is a society which gathers those who feel close to the Priestly Fraternity of Saint Peter (FSSP), and who wish to support its charism through prayers and sacrifices. Thus the Confraternity contributes to the service of the Church, through supporting numerous vocations, the sanctification of priests and their pastoral endeavors.

By decree of the Sacred Apostolic Penitentiary, dated June 7, 2008, a *plenary* indulgence is granted, under the usual conditions, to the members of the *Confraternity of St. Peter*

- a) the day of their admission;
- b) the day of the feast of the Chair of St. Peter (**Feb. 22**);
- c) the day of the feast of Sts. Peter and Paul (June 29).
