#### Ash Wednesday:

To mark the beginning of Lent, there will be the Distribution of (privately) Blessed Ashes at 7:00am followed by low Mass on Wednesday, **February 14**. The *solemn* (and public) Blessing and Distribution of ashes will take place at the Sung Mass on Wednesday, **February 14** at 7:00pm.

*Remember, this is a day of fasting and abstinence.*

### Laws of Penance, Abstinence and Fasting:

Current Law of Penance: applies to all the faithful; includes every Friday throughout the year, and every day of Lent

#### Abstinence:

*Current Law:* [binds under pain of sin]

- applies to the faithful aged 14 and older; abstention from flesh meat on Ash Wednesday & Fridays of Lent

#### *Discipline of 1962:*

- ♦ applies to those 7 years and older;
- ♦ complete abstinence on all Fridays, Ash Wednesday, Holy Saturday, Vigil of Christmas;
- ♦ partial abstinence on all the days of Lent, Ember Wednesday and Saturday

Fasting: *1 meal, 2 other meals which added together do not equal 1 full meal*

*Current Law:* [binds under pain of sin]

- applies to all aged 18 to 59 (inclusive);
- Ash Wednesday and Good Friday

#### *Discipline of 1962:*

- ♦ all non-Sundays of Lent from Ash Wed. (inclusive)

### Lenten Almsgiving:

From Ash Wednesday, **February 14** until Easter Monday, the parish will be collecting needed items for St. Augustine's Soup Kitchen and Food Pantry. Receptacles will be placed near the main entrance of the church behind the pews for your convenience. Requested items include canned goods such as chicken, tuna, vegetables, fruit, beans, ravioli, soup; mac-and-cheese, instant potatoes; pancake mix and syrup; bar soap; toilet paper; and diapers (#3 and #5).
