Friday Lenten Devotions:

Confessions: 5:00pm until 5:45pm Stations of the Cross: 6:00pm - Holy Mass: 6:30pm Adoration and Rosary: 7:00pm until 7:30pm

Laws of Penance, Abstinence and Fasting:

<u>Current Law of Penance</u>: applies to all the faithful; includes every Friday throughout the year, and <u>every day</u> of Lent

Abstinence:

Current Law: [binds under pain of sin]

• applies to the faithful aged 14 and older; abstention from flesh meat on Ash Wednesday & Fridays of Lent

Discipline of 1962:

- applies to those 7 years and older;
- <u>complete</u> abstinence on all Fridays, Ash Wednesday, Holy Saturday, Vigil of Christmas;
- <u>partial</u> abstinence on all the days of Lent, Ember Wednesday and Saturday

<u>Fasting</u>: 1 meal, 2 other meals which added together do not equal 1 full meal

Current Law: [binds under pain of sin]

- applies to all aged 18 to 59 (inclusive);
- Ash Wednesday and Good Friday

Discipline of 1962:

all non-Sundays of Lent from Ash Wed. (inclusive)

Lenten Almsgiving:
