## ANNOUNCEMENTS:

### INSTRUCTIONS ON RECEIVING PALMS

- (1) Kneel at the communion rail, rest both hands, face up, on the rail;
- (2) The blessed palm is first kissed: the priest will present the palm, simply keep the lips closed and slightly pursed;
- (3) The priest's hand is then kissed out of reverence of the human instrument of God's blessing: the priest will present the back of his hand, simply keep the lips closed, slightly pursed;
- (4) Receive the palm: cup your hands, face up, and the priest will place the blessed palm in your hands. Return to your seat.
