Feast of the Purification - Blessing of Candles:

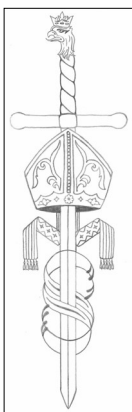
There will be a blessing of candles, and a procession at the beginning of Mass on Sunday, **February 2** at 10:00am. If you are desirous of having candles blessed for your personal use, then please be sure to bring candles that are at least 51% beeswax by 9:45am so that they may be placed in the appropriate place.

Consecration of Altar Stone: Save the Date !!

On Sunday, March 25, 1900, the Rev. Walenty Czyzewski, CSC offered the *first* Holy Mass in our parish church. In his sermon, he encouraged parishioners for continued cooperation and sacrifice. Those faithful parishioners must have taken his words to heart for we are beneficiaries of their sacrifice 125 years later! As part of the commemoration of this momentous occasion, on *this* **March 25**, Bishop Rhoades will be here at 6:30pm to consecrate a new altar stone *with a relic of St. Stanislaus* followed by solemn Mass. This is an important event, so please plan on attending!

The Parish Emblem of St. Stanislaus:

To the right is the recently commissioned emblem of St. Stanislaus. It consists of a sword piercing a bishop's miter, indicating the martyrdom of St. Stanislaus at the hand of King Boleslaw; the sword features the head of the Polish eagle and the miter bears the design featured on the statue in the main altar. The stylized "S" is taken from the medal of the Royal Order of St. Stanislaus, a royal order of knighthood founded in 1765. This is the design that will be featured in the center sanctuary window.
