Consecration of Altar Stone: Save the Date !!

In 1897, Fr. Valentin Czyzewski, CSC, pastor of St. Hedwig parish, planned a parish for the northwest side of South Bend in the "Golden Hills" area which was populated by immigrants from the Poznan area in Poland. Ground was broken in 1898 for a 600 seat church. The following year on the Feast of the Annunciation, Mass was said in the almost complete church. We will be marking the 125th anniversary of this First Mass on *this March 25*; Bishop Rhoades will be here at 6:30pm to consecrate a new altar stone *with a relic of St. Stanislaus* followed by solemn Mass. This is an important event, so please plan on attending!
