ANNOUNCEMENTS:

INSTRUCTIONS ON RECEIVING PALMS

- (1) Kneel at the rail, rest both hands, face up on the rail;
- (2) The blessed palm is first kissed: the priest will present the palm, simply keep the lips closed and slightly pursed;
- (3) The priest's hand is then kissed out of reverence of the human instrument of God's blessing: the priest will present the back of his hand, simply keep the lips closed, slightly pursed;
- (4) Receive the palm: cup your hands, face up and the priest will place the blessed palm in your hands. Return to your seat.

Holy Week Devotion:

All are invited to join the schola for *Tenebræ* on Wednesday, **April 16** at 8:00pm. *Tenebræ* is the name given to the liturgical service of Matins and Lauds belonging to the last three days of Holy Week. Although this service was traditionally held on the evening before the respective day, the liturgical books in force in 1962 do not admit this possibility for the public office of the Church. However, the St. Stanislaus Schola plans to lead a lay devotional of psalmody, lessons and chants using the traditional liturgical books for *Tenebræ* of Holy Thursday. Please come to this beautiful and powerful candlelit ceremony.

Resurrectio Capital Campaign: Update

Pledges are starting to come in! We are off to a great start! There is much to be excited about - thank you!

Once we have 50% cash in hand and the other 50% pledged, we can begin construction.

- ◆ Your regular tithing is not connected to the *Resurrectio* pledge cards;
- ◆ Pledges are not a promise to pay but rather an estimate of your total giving to the campaign over the 3-year timeframe;
- ◆ Pledge cards are to be used only for the capital campaign.
- ◆ Currently, 17% of households have already completed their pledge cards. Our goal is to have all St. Stanislaus parishioners participate in this capital campaign - many hands make light work!

Here are the two ways to pledge; please select *one*:

If you pledge on-line: This is done once, and you will then be set up for automatic payments according to the frequency and method of payment you select. A receipt will be emailed to you.

If you pledge through the card (found in your folder and at the main entrance of the church): The parish will enter your pledge into the software. You will then either mail in your payment or place it in the collection basket; be sure to have the cheque or envelope clearly marked: *Resurrectio*.

Whether you plan to fulfill your donation now or at a future date, the pledge card should still be filled out, as this will assist the parish in meeting the requirement of 50% in pledges. If you are interested in making your full 3-year pledge as a one-time gift, that can be done as well.
