##### **May Crowning:**

The annual May Crowning of Our Lady will be today, **May 4** following the 10:00am Mass. As in previous years, we would like all the children of the parish to participate in this event in a special way: the children should gather by the main entrance of the church immediately following Mass; there they will be given a flower to offer to Our Lady; they will process in the main aisle to the statue of the Blessed Virgin and will be assisted in placing their flower. Once all the children have given their flower, and returned to the pew with their family, we will process out to the grotto and back.

##### **Easter Egg Hunt:**

**Resurrectio Capital Campaign:**

If you have not set a time to collect your campaign folder, you will find it, with your name on it, at the entrance of the Church. Please pick it up at your earliest convenience.

Pledges, while they can be paid as a one-time gift, can also be spread over a 3-year period to make it less overwhelming. To break it down to see what a weekly contribution would look like spread across three years:

Divide your total pledge by 3 (years)

Divide that number by 12 (months)

Divide that number, again, by 4 (weeks)

A more manageable scenario! The progress your sacrifices are providing can be seen.

Our visual tracker at the entrance of Church now stands at \$640,000! This is a collective effort and each gift is appreciated!

We are excited to be on the agenda for a review of plans with the Diocese at the end of this month. While this is a standard procedure to ensure we have the tools needed to succeed, we are eager to show the progress of our campaign and report an update to Bishop Rhoades.

Our official launch for *Resurrectio* was March 20, and while the pledge commitment is a 3-year period, we would appreciate your pledge card being returned by **May 20**.
