Ash Wednesday:

To mark the beginning of Lent, there will be the Distribution of (privately) Blessed Ashes at 7:00am followed by low Mass on Wednesday, **February 18** The *solemn* (and public) Blessing and Distribution of ashes will take place at the Sung Mass on Wednesday, **February 18** at 7:00pm.

Remember, this is a day of fasting and abstinence.

Current Law for Fasting / Abstinence:

On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, fasting is required of those from the age of 18 through 59 inclusive; one full meal is permitted per day, two smaller meals may be taken which together would not equal a full meal. No other food may be taken. On Ash Wednesday and *all* Fridays in Lent, abstinence from meat is binding on those aged 14 and above.

Land of Peace: Items from the Holy Land

On Sunday, **February 22**, representatives from *The Land of Peace* mission (a non-profit organization) will be with us selling Crucifixes, religious art work, and rosaries - all made of olive wood which is native to Israel and Bethlehem.
