Building Project

There have been a number of questions about the "Resurrectio" building project, please know that there *is* progress being made and more information will be available for the parishioners in the next few weeks.

I (Fr. Mould) understand your concern regarding the project, but please know that some extra investigation was warranted which has contributed to the delay.

The Pre-construction investigations revealed:

-A new structural solution: the majority of work can now be done via the basement. This will eliminate the need to go through the nave floor, reducing disruption in the church itself.

-Hidden plumbing issues were uncovered: correcting these (as shown in last weeks bulletin) is essential in the long term.

-A required electrical investigation was completed: this ensures that our 125-year-old building has adequate capacity.

-The new design required a formal rebid per diocesan policy: three bids have been received and submitted to the diocese for approval.
