Resurrectio Building Project

We have arrived at the point where the contract for "Phase One" of the project has been signed by a General Contractor (Brown & Brown) and is awaiting the signature of Bishop Rhoades, which will occur when he returns from the annual meeting of the US Bishops.

This means that today is *likely* the last Sunday that we can use the basement for a few months, as the demolition will begin as soon as the contract is executed (we expect demolition to start on Tuesday).

If you have any questions, please *call* Fr. Mould.

There will be donuts available after both Masses today!

Practicalities

We need to move the stuff out of the basement, so if you are available on **Monday June 15** at **4:00pm**, we'll move everything we want to keep to the "catacombs" area.

Once the project begins, nobody is permitted to enter the basement at any time. Not even just to peak. There will be a porta-potty available on Sundays for the men of the parish, while the one indoor bathroom (at the back of the church) will be reserved for the ladies, baby changing needs and for those gentlemen who cannot physically just run outside and use the porta-potty. During the week anyone can use the indoor bathroom. The porta-potty will be cleaned on Fridays. Please, *please* have your children use the bathroom before coming to Sunday Mass and be even *more* vigilant about the bored ones needing to "go to the bathroom" for no reason.

As for noise, parents are requested to kindly take unsettled children outside/through the doors and not just to the back of the church.

Trail Life Service Project
