Marriage preparation and Weddings are available for engaged couples who are registered, attending and active parishioners of St. Stanislaus B.M. They should contact Fr. Mould to begin marriage instructions, which will be conducted over a period of at least 6 months.

Flocknote

Fr. Mould has set up "Flocknote" for the parish, this is a good way for communicating to the whole parish, to particular groups and among particular groups. It allows for sign-ups, emails and texts (among other things).

July 19 will be the last Sunday that the weekly bulletin will be sent from the parish Gmail account, from July 26 the bulletins will exclusively be sent via Flocknote, so everyone should sign up for the "Bulletin and General Announcements" group (at the minimum) by July 19.

Please be sure to include both your email and cell phone when you sign up.

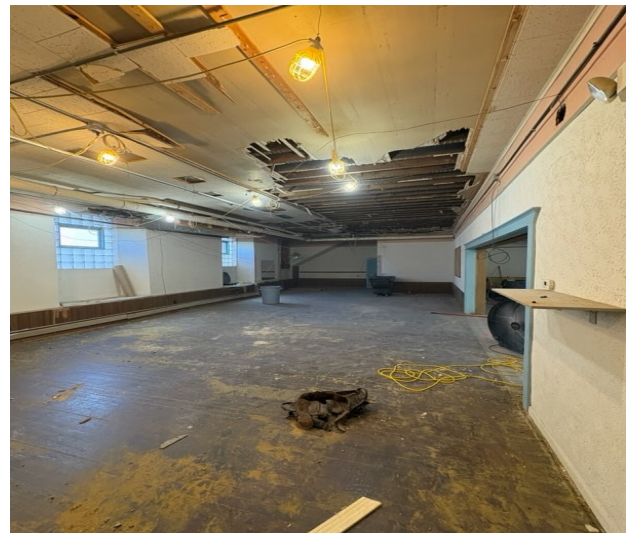
